Questions for Analyzing the Articles: Respond to these questions on a separate sheet of paper and submit at the end of class.

a. With what lens (vocabulary, perspective, omissions etc.) did you analyze your group's news articles?

b. What were your observations/findings?

c. Select several facts/arguments (3 if possible) which led you to these findings.

d. Is the reportage of this particular news event, in your opinion, true, balanced or biased? Explain.

e. Are different viewpoints presented? Are any articles an editorial (author's own ideas), are they informative, convincing, and/or balanced?

f. What are your final thoughts about the news event that your group covered? Explain your understanding of the news event itself.
